## Recommended Reads

Joshua Harris' *I Kissed Dating Goodbye* provides a seemingly radical perspective on the topic of dating. The basic premise of the book is that Harris decided not to 'date' anyone until he was ready for marriage, and saw that person as someone who he actually might marry. After several failed relationships as a young Christian man, Harris figured that there seemed to be something wrong with the concept of dating in today's world. So in the book, he explains the reasons why he thinks it would be useful not to date until one is ready for marriage, and ways in which someone can actually go about accomplishing this. He explores ideas such as maintaining purity, developing loving relationships with members of the opposite sex and the gift of singleness in a very readable book. It's also very relevant – many young people can read the anecdotes (there's heaps of them) and think, "I know someone who's like that!" or "Wow, that could be me."

That the youth will learn to encourage each other and build relationships with each other.

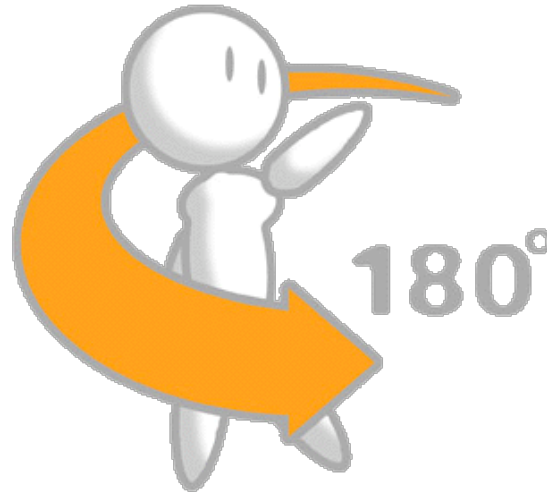
That the leaders will be able to prepare well for this coming term.
